

EXPECTED SCHOOLWIDE LEARNING RESULTS (ESLRs)

To achieve our mission, the Board of Education has adopted the following competencies as the basis of what we expect our students to know and be able to do when they are graduated from PAUSD:

ESLRs to be Measured by Report Card Grades:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of key concepts, principles, processes, facts, and skills in the disciplines of language arts, history-social science, mathematics, science, physical education, visual and performing arts, foreign language, career technical education, and health/practical living skills.

ESLRs to be Measured by the Rubrics:

2. Effective communication through listening, speaking, and writing
3. Strong research skills
4. Ability to integrate knowledge among disciplines
5. Reading with understanding
6. Critical and creative thinking to solve problems
7. Effective use of technology

ESLRs: The ESLRs addressed by each course are indicated for each department. Most departments indicate the ESLRs addressed following each course description. The numbers correspond with the numbers indicated above.

Homework Expectations: To assist students in making appropriate choices for the coming school year, the numbers of hours of work expected of students outside of class time is indicated below each course description or, in some cases, at the start of course descriptions for each department.
