<u>Financial Assistance:</u> Gunn students who have a verifiable financial need are eligible for reduced fees. You are able to request this when you register online. If you are taking multiple exams, it is also possible to register and pay for one exam at a time, so you can spread out the cost over time.

<u>Special Notes About AP **C**hinese:</u> All students registering for the AP Chinese exam will be waitlisted until February 28.

- Students will be added to the exam in the following priority: 1. Gunn students enrolled in the AP Chinese course 2. Gunn students not enrolled in the course by grade level seniority
- Due to lab size constraints, some students can expect to test on Thursday, May 24th. You will be notified of your testing date.

#### **Testing Conflicts**

You cannot take two tests at the same time and Gunn will decide which test you will take first - for example, Comp Science A and Spanish Language. You'll take one of them as a "Late Test" May 20-22. No extra fee is charged for schedule conflicts.
