1. 1/28/08 Minutes approved.
2. Budget has not changed much except the senior class has about \$1000 more in their account.
Pandora's Box would like to have a bake sale 2/12 and 14 after school. SEC approved this event.
3. Key Club is having a canned food drive from 2/25-29. The food will be donated to Second Harvest. There will be 3 bins (one in SAC, one by Spangenberg, one by Amphitheater). The club needs advertising and would like SEC to make posters and help publicize the event.
4. SEC approved all of the club proposals.
5. The class presidents are in charge of the banquet. It will be a formal, 3-course, sit down meal for the adults. Tickets may cost up to \$80 because the caterers charge very high prices. We chose 5/17 to be the date. Everyone was assigned to a group and should work with the presidents on that.
6. The Drug and Alcohol committee would like to have a "town hall" meeting with parents and students to discuss usage. They would also like assembly ideas. Possible suggested ideas were having a motivational speaker, showing a video, and showing celebrity drunk moments so people can see how ridiculous drunk people are. Ahmad also asked if we would like to do 15 minutes next year. SEC said yes but since next year will be a WASC year, it won't be possible.
7. The School Board was talking about Foothill/De Anza campus expansion ideas. They also discussed the possibility of a new IA building for Gunn.
