VTA County Busses

- **Discount VTA bus passes are available in the Gunn Student Activity Center for \$25 (check for availability with the SAC at 650-354-8229).**
- Student monthly passes may also be purchased at Safeway for \$49.

Biking & Walking

If you bike, look for the Pedal for Prizes* volunteers in the bike cage. They offer treats ranging from candy to a chance to win a bike. See bike map for safest routes to Gunn.

* Pedal For Prizes

The Pedal for Prizes program rewards students who bike to school. On monthly Prize Days, volunteers hand out treats to all incoming cyclists in the bike cage. Specially marked treats are redeemed on site for bigger prizes, including movie and school dance tickets, bike gear, Gunn t-shirts and paraphernalia, and gift certificates to local juice bars and restaurants. Chance Days also offer monthly opportunity for cyclists to enter their names in the May bike drawing. Names are written on slips of paper and deposited into a jar at the main cage's egress gate. During the Way2Go celebration in May, one lucky student's name is drawn and a new bike is awarded from our sponsor, Chain Reaction Bicycles. With the help of the PTSA and loyal parent volunteers, we are able to support cyclists and thank them for reducing traffic at Gunn.

Driving and Carpooling

Parking Rules

- ***Preferred parking nearest to classrooms is reserved for carpools.***
- Permit fees are \$125 for carpools (2 or more), and single drivers.
 - 1st week of classes: permits sold only to carpoolers.
 - 2nd week of classes: permits sold to drivers who live beyond El Camino/ Page Mill/ Foothill/ Adobe Creek.
 - 3rd week of classes: permits sold to any driver.
- No Georgia neighborhood parking.
- Palo Alto police will continue to ticket those parking without proper authorization.
- Visitors: All parked vehicles require permits to avoid ticketing. Visitors to campus are encouraged to stop by the office first thing to get a free parking permit.

Student Drop-off Area

The area by the office (the first allowable left) is reserved for carpools only.

For one-student drop-off:

- Drive towards the end of the lot.
- Turn left by the gym and drop off by covered walkway.
- Turn left at bike cage and right at main driveway.
