The Adult Education Program serves students who are at least 16 years of age and interested in completing work toward a high school diploma or a General Education Diploma. Courses are offered in a wide range of subjects leading toward a high school diploma, as well as basic skills preparation and technical training. We offer a variety of classes which include Macintosh and IBM computers, piano, foreign languages, ceramics, and much more. GED / CHSPE PREPARATION

***9495 GED CHSP**

Students desiring to complete their high school education by examination may elect to take the California High School Proficiency Examination (CHSPE) or exams for General Education Diploma (GED). Students must be 16 years of age to take the CHSPE and 18 years of age to take the GED.

Preparation for both examinations is available for credit through the Adult Education Program. Enrollment may take place at any time during the school year, and credit may be earned based upon the number of hours of attendance in the class or program.

Students who pass the GED exam must apply to the State Department of Education for their equivalency certificate, and those who pass the California High School Proficiency Examination may leave school after age 16 with parent permission.
