INSTRUCTIONS FOR COURSE REGISTRATION 2017-2018

- Print your name in the space provided above. This form is a worksheet to select courses **BEFORE** you enter them into Infinite Campus. **Online course registration will be open from February 3, 2017 - February 9, 2017.**
- All 10th grade students must take two semesters of English, Math, Science, PE, Contemporary World and US Government. You will have two slots (2 semesters each) for elective courses. In Infinite Campus under "Alternates," please select two alternates for each semester. Refer to the **2017-2018 Gunn Course Catalog** (on the Gunn Web Page) for information. Make sure you meet course prerequisite requirements before you select a course.
- Log on to **Infinite Campus** with your student ID number and password.
 - Click on "**Registration: 17-18 Henry M. High School**" from the menu on the left.
 - Courses you have already placed in your academic planner will appear in list labeled "**Required Courses.**" If you wish to change any of these courses you must do so in both IC registration **and** the Academic Planner. For questions about math and science course selections, please see your current teacher.
 - To select the rest of your courses click on the "**Course Search**" tab. In the entry field labeled "**Course Name,**" type in keywords from the course name or the course number and click "**Go.**"
 - Click on the desired course from the list that appears on the right. Click on "**Request this Course**" or "**Request as an Alternate.**"
 - Repeat the process for each course.
- Students must be enrolled in a PE class in order to receive a grade and credit. PE credit is **NOT** given for participation in sports. Please note that "0" period PE is offered. This class begins at 7:10 and meets 4x/week. Students choosing "0" period PE will have a prep period during the day; they may not take 8 classes.
- Athletes:** If you plan on participating in a Gunn sport, please type "Athletics" in the course search box. Choose the course that corresponds to the sport you anticipate playing at Gunn. These are only for Gunn sports - not club sports teams. This does not guarantee you will make the team you indicate. Do not count these when adding up the number of courses selected.
- If you do not have access to online registration, use this worksheet as your registration form. Turn it into the Guidance Office and let the secretary know that you were not able to register online.
