Second Semester Schedules (all grades)

Schedules for second semester will be viewable in Infinite Campus on December 18 at 6pm. Students are encouraged to review their schedules for any errors. Should there be a need for a change, counselors are available for students this week.

The criteria for a schedule change is as follows:

- Graduation requirement missing from schedule (12th only)
- Course already taken (10th -12th)
- Prerequisite – do not meet course requirements (9th - 12th)
- Schedule has an error (same class listed twice, class omitted, or class requested not included) (9th - 12th)
- Schedule has a class which has been taken over the summer and needs to be dropped in the fall (9th-12th)

NOTE:

We cannot accommodate schedule requests or changes based on teacher preference or learning style. We strongly believe that students benefit from learning from a variety of different teachers. (Gunn Course Catalog, p. 5)
