2019-2020 COURSE SELECTION WORKSHEET

- Print your name in the space provided above. This form is a worksheet to select courses BEFORE you enter them into Infinite Campus. Students also must complete the "Academic Planner" in Infinite Campus. **Online Course Registration will be open February 4 - February 25, 2019.**
- All 12th grade students must be enrolled in **at least 5 courses**.
- You will have **three slots for elective courses (2 semesters each)**. Rank your choice of courses for next year in order of preference and select at least 2 alternate courses under "**Alternates**." Refer to the **2019-2020 Gunn Course Catalog** (on the Gunn Web Page) for information. Make sure you meet course prerequisite requirements before you select a course.
- Log on to Infinite Campus with your student ID number and password.
 - Click on "**Registration: 19-20 Henry M. Gunn High School**" from the menu on the left.
 - Courses you have already placed in your academic planner will appear in the list labeled "**Required Courses**." If you wish to change any of these courses you must do so in both IC registration **and** the Academic Planner. For questions about math and science course selections, please see your current teacher.
 - To select the rest of your courses click on the "**Course Search**" tab. In the entry field labeled "**Course Name**," type in keywords from the course name or the course number and click "**Go**."
 - Click on the desired course from the list that appears on the right. Click on "**Request this Course**" or "**Request as an Alternate**."
 - Repeat the process for each course.
- Athletes:** If you plan on participating in a Gunn sport, please type "Athletics" in the course search box. Choose the course that corresponds to the sport you anticipate playing at Gunn. These are only for Gunn sports - not club sports teams. Indicating a Gunn sport MAY qualify you for a period prep. Requesting to join 1 or more Gunn sports team(s) does not guarantee you will make the team you indicate. Do not count these when adding up the number of courses selected.
