Open Forum

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

- Steve Ames, Tara Firenzi, and Courtney Carlomagno reported back on the Site Council Grant. See photos of the reports at the end of the minutes.
 - Steve Ames talked about the heart monitors. He is very pleased with how they are working, though he had to make new, better wristbands for them himself. He also had to work through several bugs with the company, and they company did lose the data once. The data is stored in a cloud, but is FERPA compliant.
 - It took him some time to figure out the grant, so it was not until October that he ordered the bands -- points to the Site Council having a better notification process and how to for the recipients of the Grant.
 - Tara Firenzi and Courtney Carlomagno reported back on SELF.
 - All students are in cohorts of 24-26. There is a lot of focus on relationship building with the mentors and peers.
 - They did a full pilot of the School Connect Module on SELF. 1/3 of the time was spent on school culture/logistics, 1/3 on SEL, and 1/3 on structured downtime. There are 4 units for each grade, each unit has the same 8 week structure of 1 to 2 for academic check-in, 1 intro, 3 direct SEL, 2 school culture, and 1 relationship building.
 - Structured downtime included cooking, playing games etc.
 - 2 different guest speaker days for 10th graders.
 - Moving forward, they plan to have a 2 day training for mentors before school starts. 21 mentors per class. Every mentor is in a trio for support.
 - Jane Dick was concerned about the college piece that has been moved into SELF.

- In the future, there is a plan to match students and mentors, as is done in PALY.
 - Arunim was concerned about how Titan Ambassadors will work with all classes engaged in SELF.
- Theresa McDermott spoke about the Lockheed Martin Internship. She is also responsible for the speaker series for career week. The talks were very well attended.
- There is a job fair planned for March 18th, lunchtime.
- Jane Dick, on behalf of another Gunn parent, wanted to know more about what the school is doing regarding Vaping, and whether we need Vaping Sensors. Kristina Granlund-Moyer wanted training for teachers: i.e., what should the teachers do if they detect students who have been vaping.
- November and January minutes of Site Council were unanimously approved.
- Reviewed the Grant application form. Liz Milner wanted additions around the number of students who benefit, what department is the grant request being made from, and where else they are applying for money. Arunim wanted to know if students can apply for the grants.
- There was discussion on Standards Based Grading and how it is being adapted for Gunn. The attempt is to change the focus from grades to learning.
 - Elizabeth Bonnet wanted to know how the Standards translate in terms of language classes specifically.
 - Liz Milner wanted to understand whether there was a school wide test retake policy.
- There was discussion around CAASPP, and how Pier-Angeli is working on a FAQ for parents to understand why it is important for the school that the students take this test.
 - The 10th graders will be taking the CAST (Science Pilot) at the same time.
- Elizabeth Bonnet wanted to understand the Inside Out initiative in greater detail: it is for the Gunn Athletic Advisory Committee, and how details about it are communicated to parents.



Arunim Agarwal moved to adjourn the meeting, Liz Milner seconded, and meeting was adjourned at 6:00 pm.

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

